TELANGANA LAUNCHES MAJOR DIET FACULTY RECRUITMENT TO STRENGTHEN TEACHER TRAINING NETWORK

86 Lecturer and Senior Lecturer Posts Expected to Strengthen Teacher Education Across Telangana



Teacher education experts believe strengthening DIET institutions will improve classroom quality and teacher preparedness across Telangana.

Telangana has initiated one of its most significant teacher-education strengthening exercises with the notification for 86 Lecturer and Senior Lecturer positions across District Institutes of Education and Training (DIETs). Educational experts say the move is important because DIETs train future teachers, support school reforms and improve classroom quality across government schools.

The recruitment is expected to address faculty shortages and strengthen teacher preparation ahead of future school reforms. Officials emphasize that strong DIETs will prepare educators for technology integration, inclusive education and competency-based learning that students need in the 21st century.

TELANGANA'S DIET RECRUITMENT DRIVE SEEN AS KEY STEP IN STRENGTHENING TEACHER EDUCATION

HYDERABAD: Education experts have welcomed Telangana's decision to recruit 86 Lecturer and Senior Lecturer positions across District Institutes of Education and Training (DIETs), calling it one of the most important teacher-education initiatives in recent years.

DIETs serve as the foundation of the state's teacher development ecosystem. They are responsible for preparing future educators, conducting in-service training programmes, supporting curriculum implementation and helping schools adopt new teaching methodologies.

Officials note that strengthening DIET institutions can have a multiplier effect across the education system. Better teacher educators lead to stronger teacher preparation, which ultimately improves classroom learning experiences for students.



Education planners emphasize that future teachers must be prepared not only in subject knowledge but also in technology integration, competency-based learning, inclusive education and student-centered instructional practices.

Experts believe the recruitment exercise comes at a critical time when schools are adapting to changing learning expectations and increasing demand for quality teaching.
