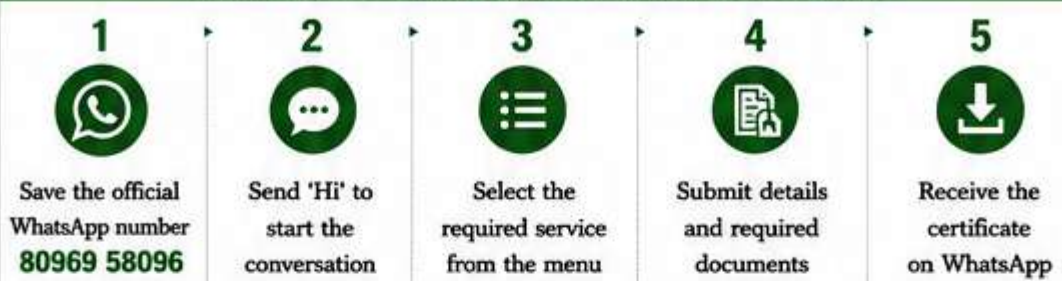

NEET 2026 EXAM ANALYSIS SUBJECT-WISE STUDENT FEEDBACK

- BIOLOGY**
Generally viewed as balanced and syllabus-oriented with NCERT-based questions.
- CHEMISTRY**
Moderate difficulty with conceptual questions dominating most sections.
- PHYSICS**
Reported by many students as the most challenging section with tricky numericals.

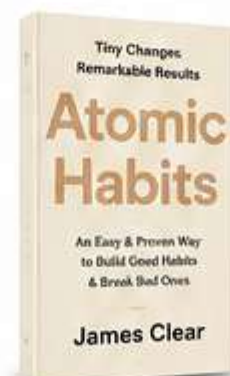

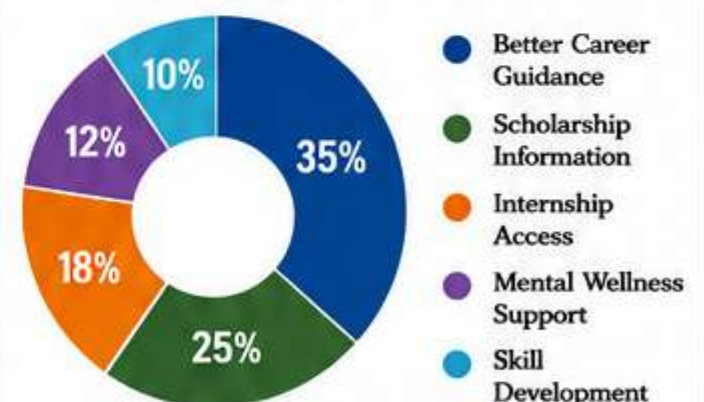
