Telangana Schools to Function on Second Saturday

Academic Calendar Adjusted to Strengthen Classroom Learning

Schools across Telangana will remain open on Saturday, July 11, as part of the state's revised academic calendar designed to recover instructional time lost during the delayed commencement of the academic year.

By utilising selected holidays as working days, schools are expected to maintain continuity in classroom instruction while providing teachers with adequate time to complete academic plans before the examination cycle begins.

Education planners believe that maintaining instructional continuity is essential, particularly during the early months of the academic year when foundational concepts are introduced.

Make It Stick explains why active recall, spaced revision, reflection and practical application strengthen memory far more effectively than repeated reading.

The book encourages students, teachers and parents to rethink traditional study habits and adopt learning strategies supported by educational research.

Its central message is simple.

Learning becomes stronger when the brain is challenged to remember rather than simply review.
